2026 Update

Once again, please accept my apologies for not being at the meeting in person. I am attending my wedding this year and marrying Azure Wolf, whose family has a place in Oak Ridge.

As a refresher, we commenced this effort back in 2017. We have now completed six stockings.

Odd-numbered years are normally when we stock, so whatever we collect now, I will use to place the order for the 2027 stocking. I need to secure our spot by late summer 2026 for the 2027 stocking, which is standard procedure. We continue to be informed that there is heavy demand for walleye fingerlings due to state funding cuts. I anticipate a small price increase, although the amount is unknown currently. Although unlikely, if there is any chance of getting at stocking this year of large fingerlings at a reasonable cost, will jump on it if we have enough donations.

Therefore, it is important that we continue to receive contributions, both large and small, to keep the effort going. We need to raise between \$3,000 (minimum) and \$6,000 (maximum available stocking capacity) to continue the program. We currently have \$1,235 raised and on the books.

We are still receiving positive reports, and some great pictures of walleye being caught have been shared with me. I always appreciate when people post them on our Facebook page (search “Walleye for Webb” and request to join if you have not already). I know some prefer not to post for various reasons, but please know that I do monitor membership. It is fantastic to see that multiple stocking classes are thriving.

Keeping a Limited Amount of Walleye

We have been working on this effort for almost ten years. Obviously, catch and release is still the best practice. We simply ask that you be reasonable and act as a good steward of the fishery.

Under no circumstances should regulations be ignored or maximized to the limit. Please see below:

NOTICE

CEDED TERRITORY REGULATIONS APPLY

**Attempts to establish walleye are ongoing.
Catch and release is essential for long-term success.**

**Three (3) walleye maximum in ceded territory
(Daily bag and possession limit)**

**Walleye must be greater than 15 inches but less than 20 inches.
One of the three may be over 24 inches.**
